2022 INTERCOLLEGIATE BAND INFORMATION

1. Nominations must be electronically submitted to John Stewart ([ICB Nomination Form](#)) by December 1, 2021.
2. Fees:
 - a. \$100.00 registration fee per student selected to participate.
 - b. Accommodation costs are either \$129 (2 nights Thurs-Fri) or \$194 (3 nights Wed-Friday) Dual occupancy.
 - c. All fee payments will be made at registration. Registration and payment must be completed electronically [here](#).
3. Directors must be current, paid members of CBDNA: enroll at www.cbdna.org
4. Students recommended for participation in Intercollegiate Band must meet the following requirements:
 - a. An enrolled graduate or undergraduate student at a North Central Division college/university.
 - b. Students must be a regular member of the institution's band program.
 - c. Each student should demonstrate the highest level of performance.
 - d. Accepted students must fully participate in all ICB expectations related to auditions, rehearsals, and the final performance.
5. Notification of acceptance of ICB nominees will be sent electronically to directors on or before January 8, 2022.
6. Music will be sent electronically to all members prior to the conference. Students are to prepare music prior to arrival for seating placement auditions.
7. Selected students will be placed in a hotel block for your stay in Madison. Students must provide transportation to the CBDNA North Central Divisional Conference. A block of rooms has been reserved at:

Students will need to secure their own accommodations for Saturday night, if necessary.

8. Each accepted student is responsible for meals. The Hampton Inn & Suites Madison/Downtown offers a free breakfast. Plan on approximately \$25-30 per day.

9. Concert dress:
 - a. Option 1 – tuxedo, white shirt, black bow tie, black shoes and socks
 - b. Option 2 – floor-length black dress or black pants and black top, black shoes
10. ICB members will be able to attend conference events that do not conflict with ICB rehearsals.
11. Directors are responsible for immediately notifying John Stewart (407-4257-2803; stewajo@uwec.edu) of cancellations or conflicts.
12. Substitutions for no-shows or unfilled sections will be covered at the discretion of the Chair.
13. Students are selected from director recommendations. Nominations received by the deadline will receive full consideration.
14. Percussion students should be listed as their primary/best performance area (timpani, keyboards, battery/auxiliary), but are expected to help cover all percussion parts in the ensemble as needed.
15. Please indicate the following doubles on the nomination form: flute/piccolo, oboe/English horn, bassoon/contrabassoon, clarinet/e-flat clarinet, bass clarinet/contrabass clarinet, alto saxophone/soprano saxophone.
16. Flutists sent piccolo music should be prepared to audition on piccolo as well as flute.
17. Auditions:
 - a. All students accepted must be prepared to audition on April 7, 2022.
 - b. Audition material will be selected from the 2022 ICB repertoire.
