# UW-Madison Mead Witter School of Music Community Music Lessons Instructor Policies

#### **General responsibilities**

Reserve a practice room in advance and begin lessons on time. Maintain contact and active communication with students and parents. Return all phone calls and e-mails from students and/or parents.

### **Rescheduling/Make-up Lessons**

Students are allowed one make-up lesson per semester. Reschedule lessons promptly. If you need to cancel due to illness or an emergency, it is your responsibility to inform the student of cancellation and schedule a make-up lesson. Students who cancel lessons must contact the instructor at least 24 hours in advance in order to receive a make-up lesson.

### Time reporting & payroll

- Time is reported through the **<u>Oracle Payroll System</u>**.
- **Do not accept tuition checks or cash** from students or parents.

### Practice room policies

- Instructors who are assigned students will be refunded their practice room fees at the end of the semester (pending Facilities Manager approval). Instructors need to teach a minimum of ten lessons during a semester to be able to get a refund.

- CML-related lessons can be scheduled during normal practice room hours. In addition to practice rooms, instructors may also reserve 2<sup>nd</sup> floor classrooms through EMS for lesson use. Classrooms are available to CML instructors Monday-Friday after 5pm and on the weekends.

## Youth Protection

CML Instructors must complete a <u>Youth Attendance Record</u> for every lesson with a minor student.

## <u>Hearing Health</u>

Hearing health is a priority as a musician. We encourage you to take the necessary steps to care for yourself and your hearing health while participating in the CML program.

#### **Important**

Teaching privately within the facilities of the school of music and outside the Community Music Lessons Program is against University Policy and is not covered by Risk Management. Should something happen to a student or parent in connection with unauthorized use of UW facilities, UW is not responsible, and you may be liable.

- It may not always be possible to complete every lesson for which each student has paid. However, we encourage Instructors to finish all the lessons that students have requested. Repeated patterns of unfinished lessons that are a result of Instructor cancellation reflect poorly on the program and the School of Music and may require reconsideration for participation as a Music Instructor.
- A parent or guardian is encouraged to be present for lessons with students who are under the age of 18.
