## Composition

When filling out the Graduate School application, please select "Music: Performance MM" or "Music: Performance DMA"

## Portfolio (due on December 1)

As part of your application, you will submit a portfolio of compositions. You may submit a maximum of 5 pieces. For each piece, please provide a PDF score and an audio recording. At least one recording must be live.

- Scores will be submitted as PDF files in the "Music: Performance" section of the application.
- Audio recordings will be submitted in the form of a single URL link to a YouTube channel
  or another file sharing site (Google Drive, etc.) in the "Portfolio" section of the application.
  Please be sure that your recordings are set to "public" or "unlisted" so that they are
  accessible to our faculty.

Your portfolio will be used for admissions review within the Composition area as well as potential funding consideration within the entire School of Music. In consultation with the faculty, you may supplement your portfolio with additional recordings/materials later in the process to be used for school-wide fellowship competitions.
